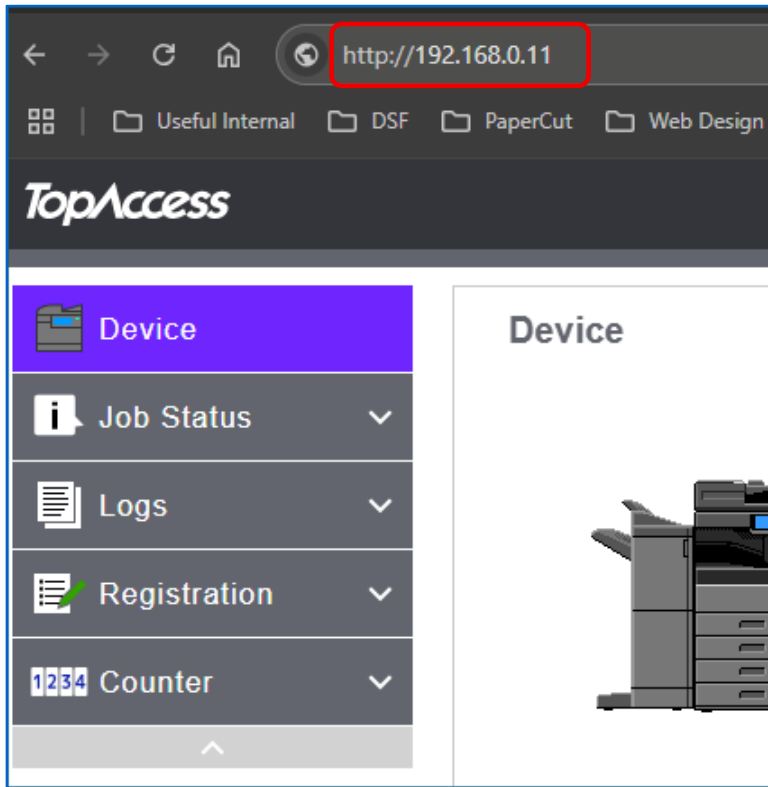

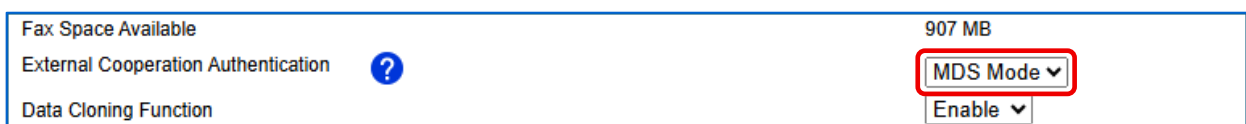

In order to remove PaperCut from your device - eBN

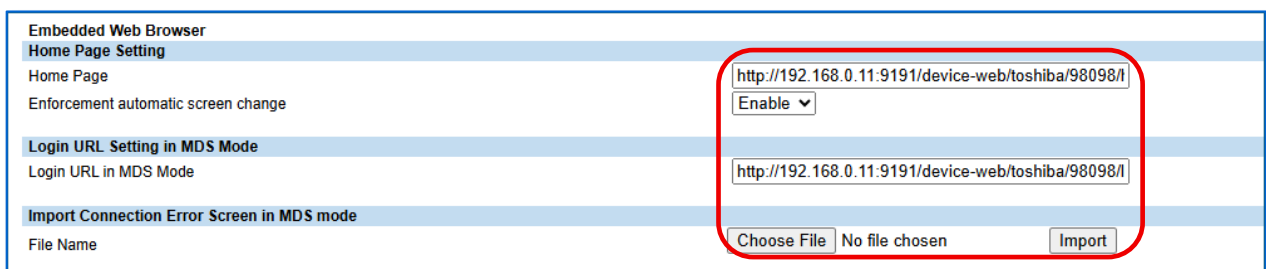
1. Browse to TopAccess via your machines IP address (192.168.0.11 example below, you use your IP address)



2. Login with your default password. This should be user: admin, password: 123456
3. Next go to Administration → Setup
4. Under General Setting you need to turn “External Cooperation Authentication” off from MDS Mode.



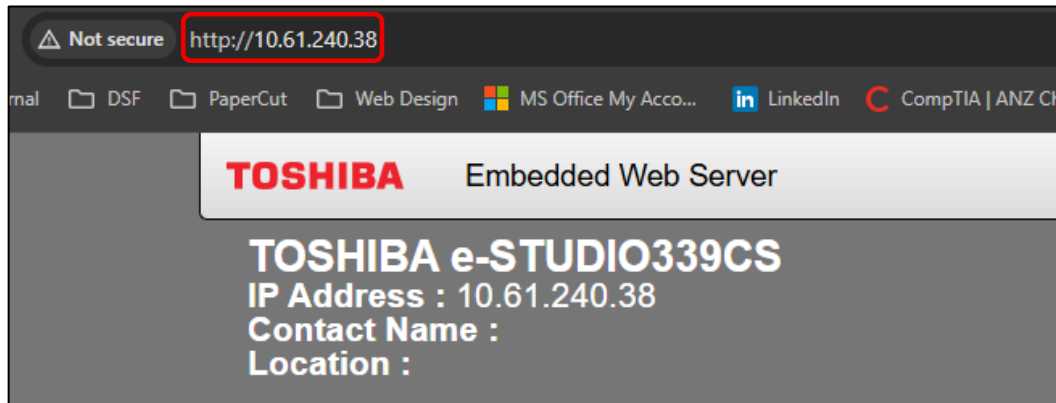
5. Next go to Administration → Setup → EWB and turn off home page setting and login URL setting or remove these entirely



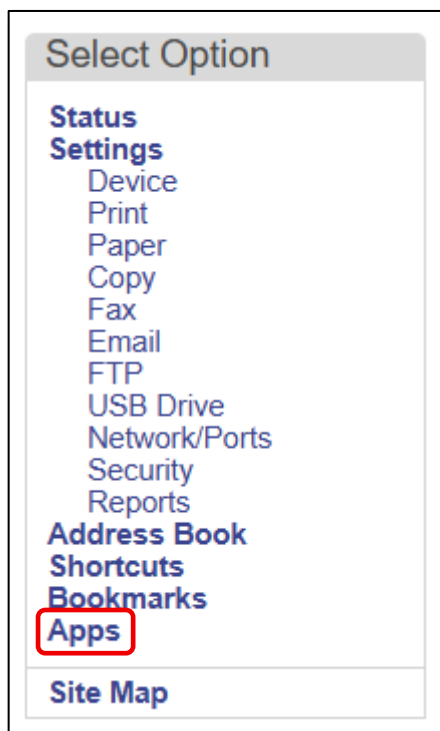
6. Save settings.
7. You may need to remove users from User Management → User Accounts. Depending on the client version you are running

In order to remove PaperCut from your device – Desktop

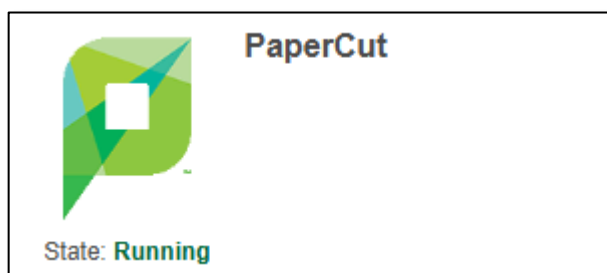
1. Browse to the Embedded Web Server via your machines IP address (10.61.240.38 - example below, you use your IP address)



2. Front the side menu, click on [Apps]



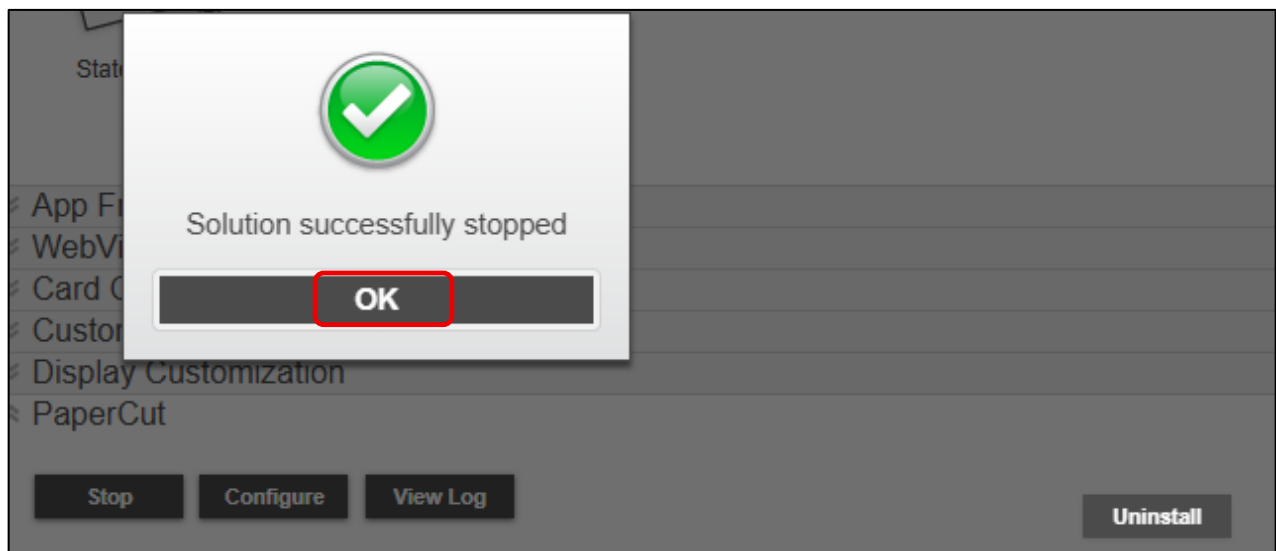
3. Browse to the PaperCut App



4. Click on the PaperCut App



5. Click on Stop and then press on OK



6. If never using again you can also Uninstall here



Note: this must be removed from desktop device PRIOR to taking it off site. Otherwise, a factory reset will be required as the app will continue to look for the previous PaperCut Server setup.
