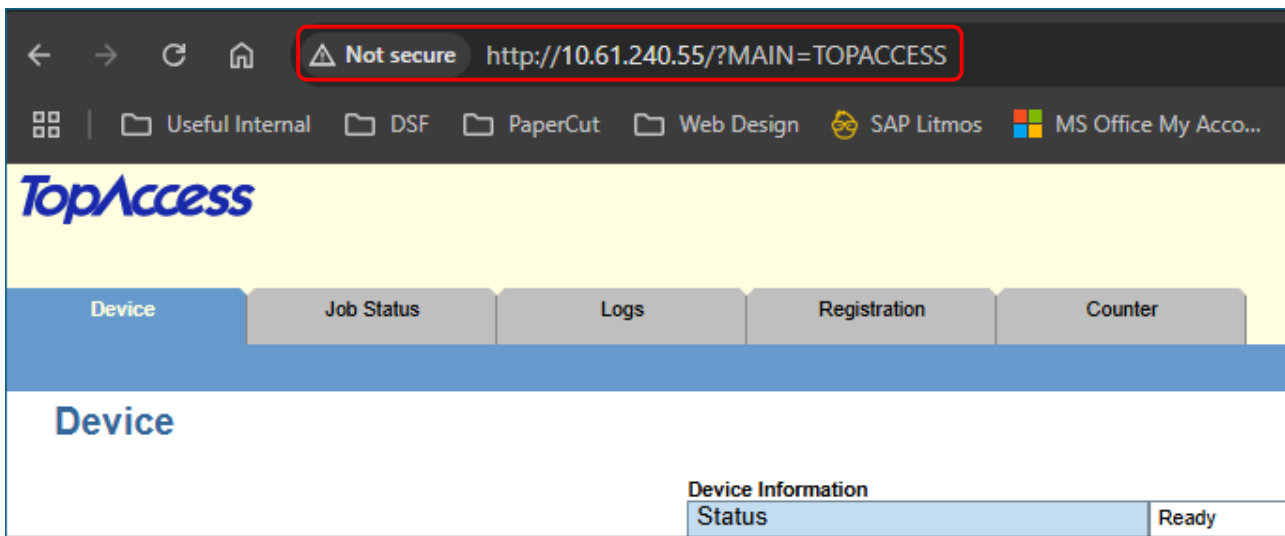

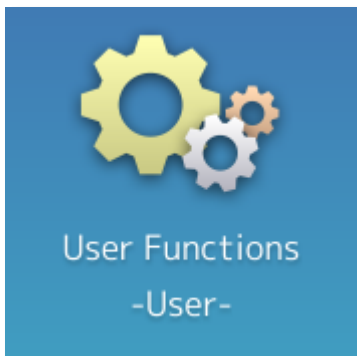

Creating a Clone file for backup purposes

1. You will need to login the web interface for your copier via it's IP address (Network address)



2. If you don't know what this is go to user functions / user on the front panel



3. Once pressed go to the admin tab at the bottom in the middle. Your Password is 123456 (default)
4. Then go to Network → IPV4 and grab the IP address on the top line. Should be something like 10.1.2.33 (example)
5. Input the IP Address into the browser as in the first image.
6. You will have a login button on the top right of the screen press this.
7. User is Admin / password is again 123456

8. Once logged in go Administration → Maintenance

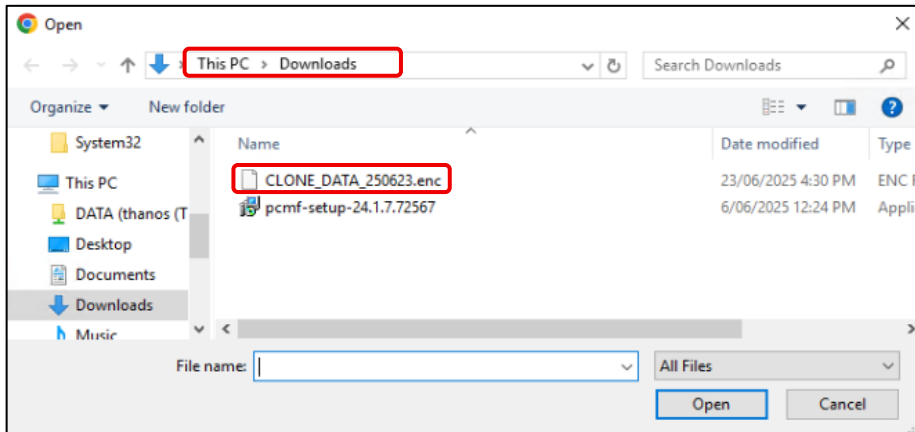
11. Here you can add a password or leave it blank. We'll leave blank for this exercise, click on OK

12. You will then get the spinning circle as it creates your clone. When you get the blue link, right click here and save as.

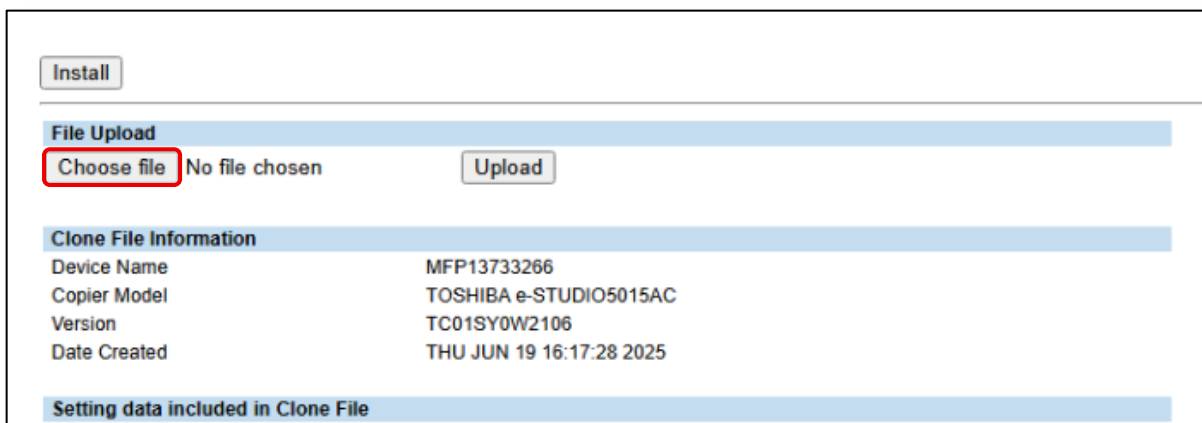

13. Put this file into a folder to transfer to your new copier is setup

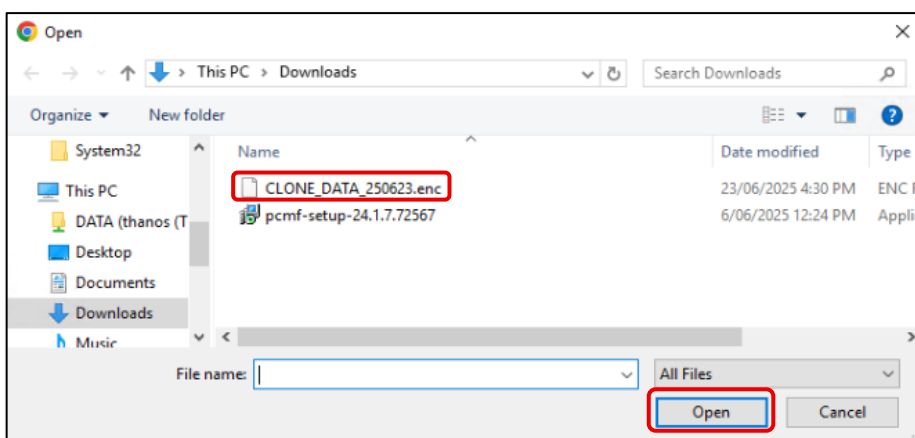


Restoring your clone file

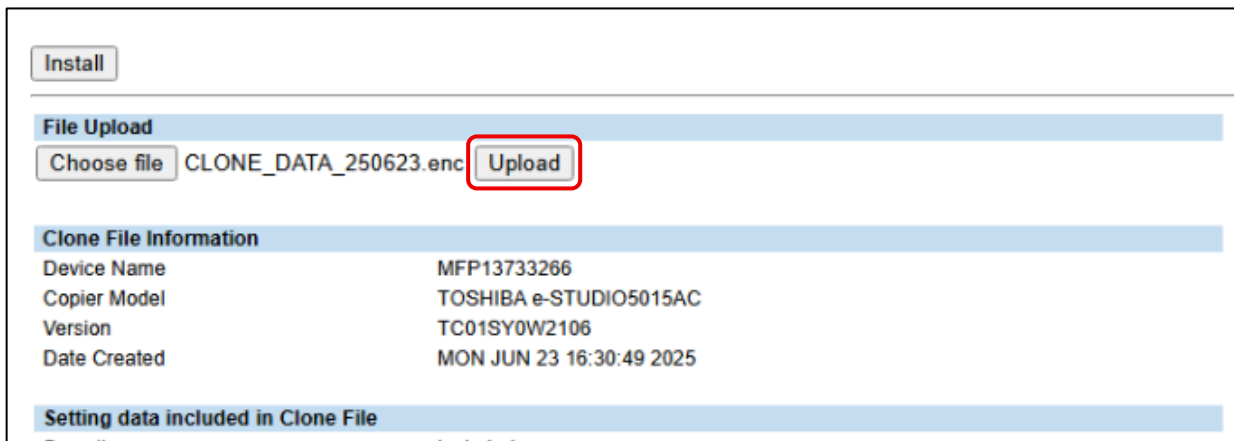
1. Choose Install Clone from the Maintenance menu. Click on Choose file



2. Browse to the folder where you clone file is located and Open



- Once the file is chosen, click on Upload

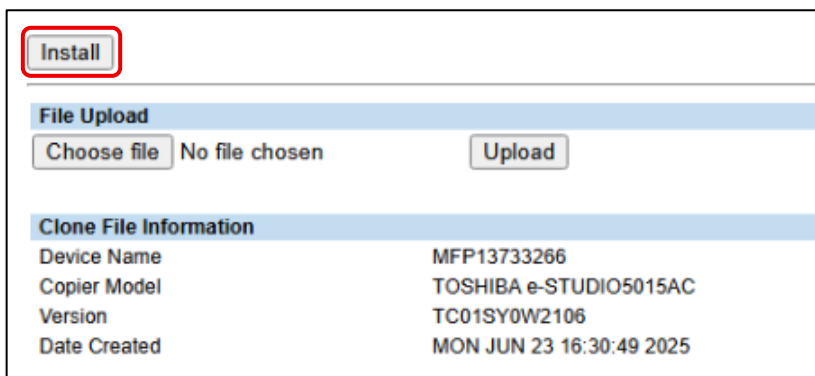

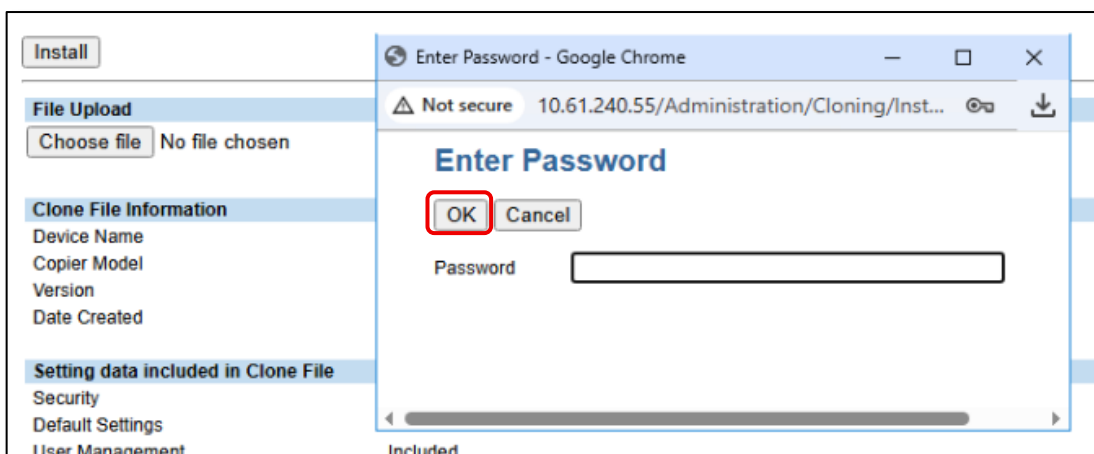

- Once uploaded your clone file will appear. Click Install



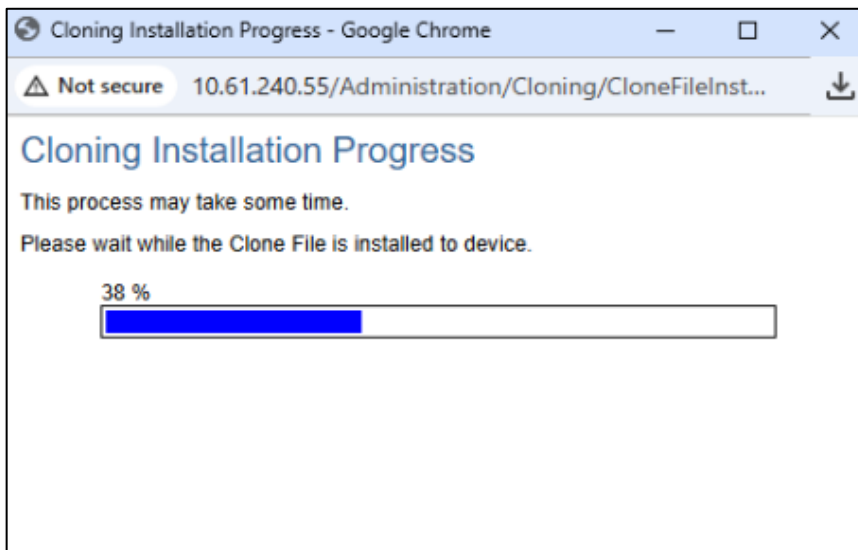

- Next click on the install button. We didn't use a password, but if you did input it here

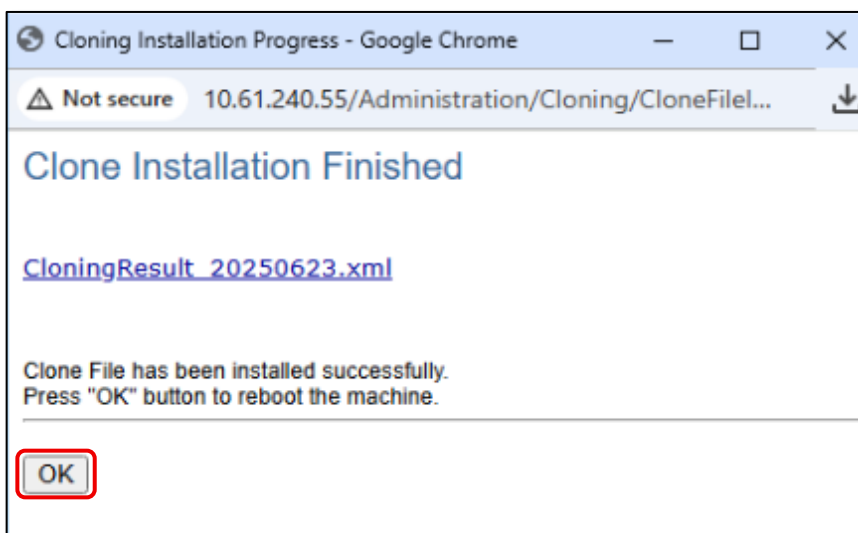
