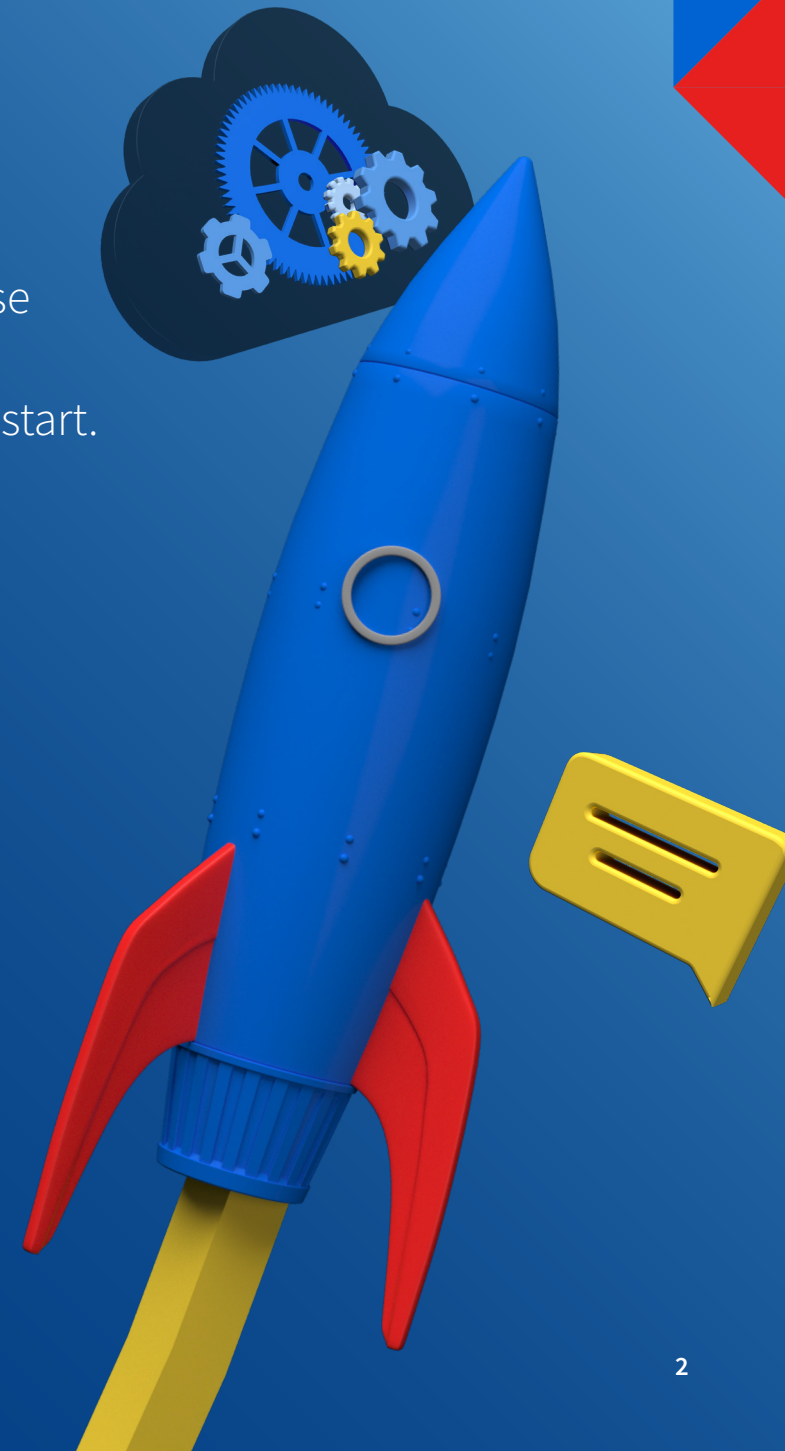

Improving invoice processing with finance automation

- Route invoices into a multi-step approval process that supports split code billing for multiple approvals, migrating tasks from one employee to the next to **keep processes flowing**
- **Automatically post** approved invoice amounts directly back into ERP and finance systems (SAP, Microsoft Dynamics, QuickBooks, Sage and more)
- **Dynamically handle** exception-level approvals and reprocess rejected invoices
- **Automatically pre-approve** invoices under a set value threshold
- Initiate automatic 3-way match processes that enable invoices to move from initial capture to approval flows with **no manual intervention**
- **Instantly get answers** to questions like: When was this invoice recorded? Where is it now and who accessed it last?
- Utilise **intelligent indexing** to search for specific invoices or terms – by amount, invoice number, product line descriptor and more
- **Securely store** documents in a compliant way
- Undertake compliance audits and financial reporting in **hours – not weeks**



By eliminating repetitive manual tasks in an auditable and highly transparent way that accelerates invoice processing capabilities, it becomes simple to work quicker and smarter.

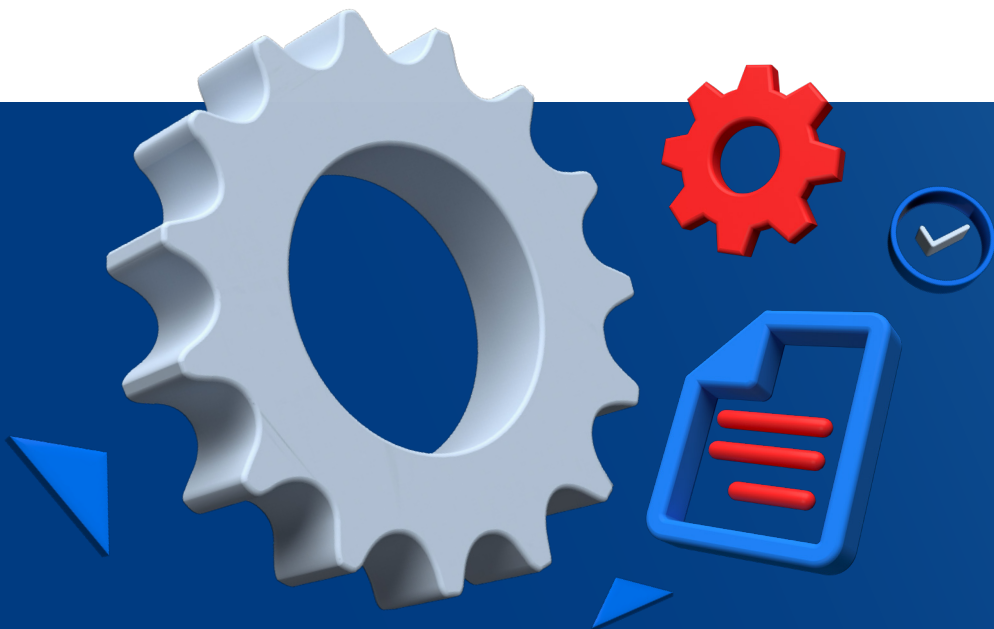

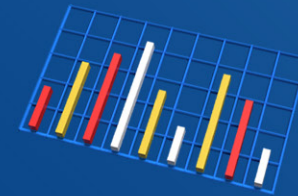
