



Desktop A4 MFDs (All Series)

1. First you need to create a directory to scan to. To do this open Windows Explorer. Right click in the white section and create a **“New Folder”** called C:\>Scans.




2. Then right click on your Scans folder, go to **“Properties”** and **“Advanced Sharing”**. This should have Shared Permissions for Admin and Everyone.




Scanning to PC – Desktop A4 Series 1


1. Go to Web browser interface for MFD



2. Next we need to go to “Set up Scan to Network”



3. Here you need to click on “Add”. If you want to setup custom buttons use “Click here”



4. Pressing click here will open up all options below. Including “Import” and “Export” functions




7. Go to Web browser interface for MFD via its network address (IP Address)



8. Then click on “Apps” on the left hand menu



9. Click on “Scan Centre” – Network folders then click on “Configure”



10. Configure the name of your **“Scan shortcut”**, **“Domain”**, **“Path”**, **“Authentication Options”** and **“User name”** and **“Password”**, then click on **“Test Connection”** to ensure settings are correct. Then click on **“Save”**
